Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents no.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents no.4 to 6.

In compliance of order dated 4.4.2016, learned counsel for the petitioners has produced a photocopy of the FDR from Punjab National Bank, Ludhiana, for an amount of Rs.50,000/,

in the name of petitioner no.1-Kiranjeet Kaur, which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel has produced the statements of Kiranjeet Kaur, petitioner no.1 and Balveer Kaur, respondent no.4, which are taken on record. The aforesaid statements suggest that there is no objection to the alleged marriage of the petitioners from the private respondents and further, there is no danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners from them.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.

However, in case the petitioners still feel that there is any threat to their life and liberty, they may approach Senior Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, respondent no.2, who shall redress their grievance, if any, in accordance with law.
