Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of F.I.R. No.30 dated 17.6.2011 under Sections 283, 304-A and 427 IPC registered at Police Station Gardhiwala, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 4.3.2014 (Annexure P-2).

This Court vide order dated August 19, 2014 had directed the parties to appear before learned trial Court to get their statements recorded and the trial Court was directed to determine the authenticity of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, the parties have appeared before

learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Dasuya and have got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded by the parties, learned Magistrate has submitted his report dated 8.9.2014 to the effect that the matter has been compromised between the parties through the intervention of the respectable, without any pressure or coercion and the compromise is genuine one.

The factum of compromise between the parties has not been disputed by learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the respondent No.2.

In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R.

Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052* and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, this petition is allowed and F.I.R. No.30 dated 17.6.2011 under Sections 283, 304-A and 427 IPC registered at Police Station Gardhiwala, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed, on the basis of compromise dated 4.3.2014 (Annexure P-2).
