Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the State should be directed to register the FIR against respondent Nos.4 to 10 for forcibly and illegally entering in shop No.3076/C near Bus Stand, Adampur, District Jalandhar.

In these circumstances, the petitioner is relegated to avail the remedy before the police by filing an appropriate complaint/representation and if no action is taken thereupon, then file a complaint/representation before the concerned Illaqa Magistrate with appropriate request under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C.
