The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 16 dated 24.02.2016 registered at Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana under Sections 363,366-A IPC

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that this is a case of run away marriage and the girl was more than 18 years of age and she has given an affidavit that she has gone on her own and they have placed on record copy of the certificate which contains her photographs and signatures. He further states that petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Learned State counsel submits that cancellation report has been prepared and they shall file the same.

The petition is allowed subject to the condition that the petitioner will join the investigation as and when required by the police and will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation and will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
