Report dated 22.04.2016 sent by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Gurdev Singh, Beant Singh, Shinder Singh, Jaspal Singh and Jagjeet Singh as well as of complainants Bakhtour Singh, Lakhvir Singh, Mangal Singh and Nank Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not heinous in nature and that this compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR**

Criminal 1052, FIR No.127 dated 30.08.2010 under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 IPC Police Station, Sadar, Moga District Moga and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
