TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.334 dated 03.09.2015, under Sections 420, 406 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar.

Since quashing was sought on the basis of compromise, parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court for recording of their statements in support of the compromise and a report regarding veracity of the same was called for.

Placed on record is a report dated 23.05.2016 of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri. Perusal of such report would reveal that statements of the complainants Sanjeev Kumar and Gopal Bakshi as also of the accused party/petitioners herein have been duly recorded and it has been opined that the compromise has been effected

without any pressure or coercion.

Counsel appearing for the complainants/respondents No.2 and 3 has also made a statement that the compromise has been effected and he would have no objection to the quashing of the FIR.

In the present case, the parties having amicably resolved the dispute, it would be a fit case for this Court to interfere and to bring to an end the criminal prosecution initiated in the light of impugned FIR.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.334 dated 03.09.2015, under Sections 420, 406 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar qua the petitioners is hereby quashed.
