Prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner-Rajpreet Singh @ Kala in case FIR No.36 dated 18.04.2015 for the offences punishable under Sections 22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered with Police Station Badhni Kalan (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations, recovery of 500 grams of intoxicating powder, containing salt Alprazolam, was effected from the possession of the petitioner, which quantity concededly is commercial in nature.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. He further submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by H.C. Nirmal Singh, submits that the quantity of the contraband recovered from the petitioner falls within the definition of commercial, therefore, the petitioner is not entitled to bail. She further submits that challan has been presented.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
