Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner/accused-Davinder Singh in case FIR No.43 dated 10.07.2015, under Sections 22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act (for short 'NDPS Act'), registered with Police Station Sadar Budhlada, District Mansa (**Annexure P-1**).

The alleged recovery is *05 vials of Rexcof Cough Syrup*, each containing 100 ML from the possession of the petitioner/accused, which quantity concededly is non-commercial in nature.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 10.07.2015 and only 01 out of 06 official prosecution witnesses has been examined. He further submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Jaspal Singh, is unable to refute the aforesaid factual position.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period, the seized quantity being non-commercial in nature and the fact that trial is not likely to be concluded in near future, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
