This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under
Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.60 dated 01.03.2016 registered under
Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, at P.S. City Rewari.

On 05.04.2016 the following contention was noticed:

*“Petitioner seeks the concession of pre-arrest bail
in a case registered at the instance of Ram Mina alleging
that the petitioner had taken a sum of approximately Rs.
10.90 lacs from the complainant for getting job in Railway
to son and brother-in-law of complainant.”*

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Surender Kumar states that the on enquiry from Howrah Police, it transpired that neither the petitioner or his son were complainant in Howrah nor he is a witness.

In the circumstances, the basic premises on which the petitioner had been granted interim bail seems to be correct.

Petition dismissed.
