The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail to the petitioner pending trial in case FIR No.46 dated 10.03.2015 under Sections 15/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Jakhal, District Fatehabad.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is 77 kgs. of poppy husk.

Petitioner was apprehended on the spot and arrested on 10.03.2015.

In view of such heavy and commercial quantity having allegedly been recovered, this Court is not inclined to entertain the prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to the trial Court to expedite the trial and in any case to conclude the same within a period of four months from today.

Such directions are being issued as State counsel has apprised that out of 12 prosecution witnesses cited, 7 have already been examined and it is only official witnesses that remain to be examined.
