By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in case FIR No.132, dated 25.09.2015, registered under Sections 306 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC'), at Police Station Raikot, District Ludhiana (Rural).

The learned counsel for the petitioner refers to the testimony of the complainant, Jasbir Kaur, wherein she had stated that she deposed under the influence of police officials and the petitioner was not at fault to abet the deceased to commit suicide.

Therefore, the learned counsel contends that the complainant has not supported the case of the prosecution. The petitioner is in custody since 25.09.2015.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application.

Heard.

There are specific assertions in the FIR against the petitioner. The effect of the testimony of the prosecution witnesses shall be assessed by the trial Court at an appropriate stage. This Court is not inclined to grant the bail at this stage.

Dismissed.
