This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.44 dated 10.8.2014 under sections 21, 22, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, Kabirpur (Ahlikalan), District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version the alleged recovery from the present petitioner is of 100 grams of Alprazolam and 4 grams of heroin.

Concededly, the alleged recovery from the petitioner would be construed as non-commercial in nature. Petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other proceedings under the N.D.P.S Act.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Kapurthala.

Petition disposed of.
