This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.99 dated 20.5.2015 under sections 420, 468, 471, 506, 120-B I.P.C registered at Police Station, Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

Allegation in a nutshell against the present petitioner is that by preparing fake and forged documents i.e. Ration Card, Voter Card etc. he has secured appointment for his wife Gayatri Devi as an Aanganwari Worker in the village.

Complainant is Ruby Rani, who was also an applicant for the post of Aanganwari Worker in the same process of selection.

Petitioner was arrested on 16.2.2016.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan stands presented on 16.4.2016.

Trial is still at the initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Offences are triable by a court of Magistrate.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari.

Petition disposed of.
