Prayer is under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of regular bail to the petitioner-Rajwinder Singh @ Raji in case FIR No.01 dated 03.01.2016 for offences punishable under Sections 22/61/85 NDPS Act registered with Police Station Sadar, Budhlada, District Mansa.

Petitioner was apprehended and a recovery of 500 tablets of Zelpra-0.5 was effected.

It is contended that the recovery is non commercial in nature, therefore, bar under Section 37 for grant of bail is not applied. It is further contended that petitioner is a young boy of 23 years of age and is stated to be in custody since 03.01.2016. It is further stated that after completion of investigation challan stands presented and case is at the stage of

commencement of prosecution evidence.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Jaspal Singh does not refute the aforesaid submissions made on behalf of the petitioner.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future, present petition is allowed and the petitioner Rajwinder Singh @ Raji is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, Mansa.

Petition stands disposed of.
