Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely, Balwinder Singh @ Billa, Balwinder Singh @ Bau and Narinder Singh @ Buddu in case FIR No.14 dated 25.01.2016 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 325, 452, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Kambo, District Amritsar Rural.

As per the allegations of the complainant Lovepreet Singh three accused accompanied by six other co-accused entered their house at night around 11.00 pm and inflicted injuries upon the complainant and his brother Jasbir Singh.

Petitioner no.1 is attributed a *Kirpan* blow on the back of the head of injured Jasbir Singh, while petitioner no.2 gave a *Kirpan* blow on the head of Jasbir Sigh. Petitioner no.3-Narinder Singh is attributed a

Datar blow on the forehead of the complainant.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that there is a delay of 12 days in lodging the FIR and there is a version and cross version and the accused party has also suffered injuries.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioners, no case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made out as apart from the injuries attributed, it is not in dispute that the complainant and his injured brother Jasbir Singh were discharged from the hospital, on 20.1.2016. The arguments raised would be moot points at the time of trial, however, at the stage of investigation keeping in view the nature and gravity of alleged offences, custodial interrogation of the Petitioner would be required for proper and fair investigation.

Dismissed.
