JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Jagsir Singh @ Lakhvir Singh in case FIR No.32 dated 28.02.2016 for offences punishable under Sections 15/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered with Police Station Dayalpur, District Bathinda.

There is alleged recovery of 52Kgs & 500 grams of Poppy Husk from the car owned by the present petitioner-accused. Although he is alleged to have fled away from the spot.

It is contended that a false case has been foisted upon the petitioner. That apart it is contended that the alleged recovery is marginally commercial and as on date there is no case pending against the petitioner, more so under the NDPS Act.

Learned State Counsel assisted by HC Jarnail Singh submits that the petitioner stands convicted and sentenced for life in murder case. He next submits that the co-accused apprehended from the spot has specifically named the present accused as also the car used for carrying the contraband belongs to the petitioner.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition to enable his client to surrender before the trial Court and thereafter seek regular bail.

The oral prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn. However, the trial Court in the event of surrender of the petitioner and institution of regular bail, would decide the said application expeditiously.
