This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.18 dated 17.2.2016 under sections 379, 411 I.P.C (sections 413, 482 I.P.C were added later on), registered at Police Station, Sadar Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, on the basis of secret information a Bolero Pick-up vehicle bearing registration no.PB-04-M-8002 was intercepted and 70 bags of rice were recovered. No person was apprehended on the spot.

The petitioner is sought to be implicated on the basis that he is the owner of the vehicle in question and 15 bags of rice were also stated to have been recovered from him.

Petitioner was arrested on 19.2.2016.

Investigation in the case is complete and challan stands presented. Trial is stated to be at the very initial stage. The offences are triable by the court of a Magistrate.

Without making any observations, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Faridkot.

Petition disposed of.
