This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.161 dated 8.5.2015 under section 136 of Electricity Act, registered at Police Station, Pundri, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

Petitioner is in custody since 17.9.2015 in the present case on the allegations that copper coils and other transformer material of a transformer installed in the fields of one Bhag Singh were stolen. Loss on account of such theft assessed by the U.H.B.V.N. Ltd. is of Rs.22,000/-. Petitioner has been implicated on the basis of his own confessional statement recorded while in custody in a separate case i.e. F.I.R No.245 dated 25.7.2015.

Investigation in the present case is complete and challan has been presented.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Kaithal.

Petitioner will be enlarged on bail, if, not under arrest in some other criminal proceedings.

Petition disposed of.
