This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.733 dated 17.11.2015 registered under Sections 66, 66-A I.T. Act and 384, 388, 389 and 120-B IPC at Police Station City Palwal, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the case of the petitioner is similar to the case of the petitioner in CRM-M No.1139 of 2016 (Annexure P-2) and he has been granted bail by this Court. The petitioner is in custody since 17.11.2015.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Dharam Pal has accepted the fact that the similarly situated co-accused has been released on bail.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny him the concession of bail.

Bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Palwal.
