Prayer made in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for transfer the investigation in case FIR No.37 dated 11.04.2015 registered at Police Station Raja Sansi, Distt. Amritsar Rural under Section 326/323/341/34 IPC to some other independent agency or to appoint some other Senior Officer to conduct the investigation.

On notice of motion having been issued, reply dated 10.08.2016 has already been filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 by way of affidavit of Amandeep Kaur, Dy. Superintendent of Police, Rajasansi, Distt. Amritsar (Rural).

As per reply, the abovesaid FIR was registered against Baljinder Singh and Narinder Singh sons of Jarnail Singh and Tehpal Singh son of Narinder Singh all residents of Rakh Uthian, Distt. Amritsar. Reply further reveals that during investigation, matter was investigated at the spot duly verified by the then Halqa Supervisory

Officer Shri Gurnam Singh PPS, then DSP Sub Division, Rajasansi, Distt. Amritsar (Rural) and found that no injury was caused to the complainant at the spot except exchange of hot words.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the police has prepared a cancellation report.

In view of the aforesaid stand taken in the said reply more particularly when the police has prepared a cancellation report, present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file protest petition in case he is not satisfied with the cancellation report.
