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**JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)**

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Tarun Kumar in case FIR No.21 dated 26.02.2016 for offences punishable under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station City Mansa, District Mansa.

The FIR was lodged on a secret information that non applicants/co-accused Suresh Kumar @ Bunt, Gagandeep Singh @ Gagan, Yadwinder Singh @ Yadi, Kuldeep Singh @ Kala son of Hari Singh, Kuldeep Singh s/o Ajaib Singh, Sandeep Singh and petitioner had formed a Gang and used to cheat Flipkart Company by buying expensive mobiles and then seeking refund of the price by returning defective mobiles.

It is submitted that the company-Flipkart has not come forward

to complain of cheating and it is only on the basis of secret information.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that although petitioner did not have any interim protection yet he has joined investigation and furnished the details.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Pardeep Kumar submits that petitioner has not joined investigation and he being the kingpin of planning of operations his custodial interrogation is required to unearth the modus operandi.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of offence and the stand of the State, no case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
