Report dated 11.05.2016 sent by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Jagraon has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Balwant Kaur and Gagandeep Kaur as well as of complainants Darshan Singh and Paramjit Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not heinous in nature and that this compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.61 dated 28.02.2005 under Sections

452,341,323,506,34 IPC Police Station, Jagraon, District Ludhiana and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
