JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Three petitioners-accused, namely, Raj Singh @ Rajwinder Singh, Minto Singh and Kuldeep Singh are seeking regular bail under Section 439 Cr.PC in case FIR No.79 dated 07.11.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 307, 323, 341 and 34 of Indian Penal Code and Section 325 IPC added later on registered with Police Station City-I, Mansa, District Mansa.

It is contended that even if the allegations in the FIR are taken on their face value, injury no.1 over the forehead, which has been opined to be attracting the offence under Section 307 IPC is attributed to the co-accused Radhey Sham. The injuries attributed to the present petitioners are

on the thigh, right calf and left ankle, which have been opined to be simple in nature.

It is submitted that the petitioners are in custody since 14.12.2015 and after completion of the investigation challan stands presented.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Amrik Singh does not refute the aforesaid factual position.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the above and that trial is not likely to be concluded in near future, no useful purpose is going to be served by keeping the accused behind the bars. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and petitioners, namely, Raj Singh @ Rajwinder Singh, Mintoo Singh and Kuldeep Singh are ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, Mansa.

Petition stands disposed of.
