This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.97 dated 13.3.2015 under sections 136/137 of Indian Electricity Act, registered at Police Station, Pundri, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

Allegations against the present petitioner are with regard to theft of copper coils and other transformers material from the transformers installed in the fields.

Petitioner has been implicated on the basis of his own confessional statement recorded while in custody in a separate case i.e. F.I.R No.245 dated 25.7.2015 and which was also registered on similar allegations.

Court has been apprised that as many as 30 F.I.Rs have been registered on similar allegations and in which the present petitioner has been implicated.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan already stands presented.

It has gone uncontroverted that pertaining to case F.I.R no.161 dated 8.5.2015 under section 136 of the Indian Electricity Act, registered at Police Station, Pundri, District Kaithal and F.I.R No.245 dated 25.7.2015 for the same very offence also registered at Police Station Pundri, District Kaithal the petitioner has been granted benefit of bail vide order dated 11.4.2016 passed in CRM No. M-11921 of 2016 and order dated 26.11.2015 passed in CRM No. M-39001 of 2015 respectively.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Kaithal.

Petition disposed of.
