Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 04.04.2016. The photographs of the marriage and marriage certificate have been placed on file as Annexure-P-3. The Secondary School Examination Certificates of petitioner Nos.1 and 2, showing their date of birth have been placed on file as Annexures-P-1 and P-2 respectively. They also claim that they apprehend danger to their life from the private respondents.

In these circumstances, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, to assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be taken to be the proof of valid marriage.

Disposed of accordingly.
