AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.66 dated 11.07.2015, registered under Section 61/1/14 Excise Act and 420 IPC, at Police Station Kathunagal, District Amritsar.

It is stated that pursuant to the order dated 08.04.2016 the petitioner has appeared and has been granted interim bail by the trial Court.

Learned Additional Advocate General, on instructions from ASI Jatinder Singh has accepted this factual assertion.

In these circumstances, without going into the merits of the

case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 08.04.2016 is made absolute. Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
