Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Ranvir Singh @ Bir in case FIR No.101 dated 20.11.2015 for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 452, 380, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Nurmahal, District Jalandhar City.

The allegations are that on the night of 19.11.2015 at 11.00 pm, the petitioner-accused accompanied by other co-accused entered the house of the complainant-Surinder Singh and inflicted injuries on his person.

It was contended that the petitioner is attributed two *Kirpan* blows on the face of the complainant-Surinder Singh and as per the MLR, both of them have been opined to be simple in nature. The alleged theft of Rs.3000/- has been recovered from the co-accused Neeraj who has been granted regular bail by the trial Court.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated with the same and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Gursharan Singh, concedes the aforesaid situation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 07.04.2016, is made absolute.
