The present petition was filed by the petitioner challenging the notification dated 15.6.2000 (Annexure P-3) issued by the Mines and Geology Department, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the State submitted that with the lapse of time, the prayer made in the present petition has been rendered infructuous. In terms of notification under challenge, the applications were invited. The mining lease had been granted to one Ashok Kumar. He has not even been impleaded as party in the petition.

Dismissed as infructuous, however, with liberty to the petitioner to get the same revived within a period of three months, if any relief, still survives in the present petition.
