Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondents No.4 to 6 for not interfering in their married life.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in terms of order dated 7.4.2016, petitioner No.2 has deposited Rs.1,00,000/- in the shape of FDR in Punjab and Sind Bank in the name of petitioner No.1 Savneet Kaur. He also produced a

photocopy of the note of FDR. Same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid fact rather on instructions from HC Randhir Singh submits that on 16.4.2016 petitioner No.1 Suvneet Kaur had made a statement before the police that she needs protection from respondents No.4 to 6. He further submits that thereafter on 28.4.2016 petitioner No.2 Avtar Singh has made statement before the police that they need not any protection and the said statement has been signed by both the petitioners. Photocopy of the both statements are taken on record.

In view of the latest statement of petitioner No.2-Avtar Singh dated 28.4.2016, in which they submit that they do not need any protection and the said statement has been signed by both the petitioners, no further order is required to pass in the present petition.

Disposed of.

However, in case the petitioners feel any danger to their life and liberty, they are at liberty to approach respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda.
