Prayer in this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the accused/petitioner-Rohit Kumar alias Rohit alias Karan Singla, in case FIR No. 160, dated 04.09.2015, for offences punishable under Sections, 307, 326, 324, Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda.

As per allegations, accused/petitioner has attacked injured-Manohar Lal, brother of the eye-witness-complainant (Yashpal) with a knife and inflicted five injuries on his stomach, back and other portion of the body.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 09.09.2015.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Mander Singh, states that two injuries on the abdomen of Manohar Lal (injured) were declared as dangerous to life, while one on the left side of the chest were declared as grievous in nature. He, thus, submits that keeping in view the manner of inflicting of the said injuries, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
