This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent No. 4 i.e. Station House Officer, Macchiwara, to submit status report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. and also submit the report of the investigation, conducted by the police in FIR No. 72 dated 14.4.2015, registered under Sections 406, 420, 342, 506, 120-B IPC at Police Station Macchiwara, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana. Further direction is sought from respondents No. 1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and to take legal action against private respondents No. 5 to 9 in the present FIR.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that FIR No. 72 dated 14.4.2015, registered under Sections 406, 420, 342,

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506, 120-B IPC at Police Station Macchiwara, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana, against the present petition. The private respondents No. 5 to 9 are influential persons and the police is not submitting the final report to the concerned learned Illaqa Magistrate.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 4-Station House Officer, Police Station Macchiwara, to submit the final report of investigation before the concerned learned Illaqa Magistrate, within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
