Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Darshan Kaur in case FIR No.142 dated 11.11.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 304 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Rajasansi, District Amritsar.

As per allegations the petitioner had taken Manpreet Kaur (since deceased) to an untrained Midwife for her delivery which resulted in her death.

It is contended that deceased Manpreet Kaur was M.Sc. While the petitioner is illiterate villager and deceased had consented for her

delivery by the said Midwife available in the area. It is further contended that there was absolutely no intention to cause any harm to her deceased daughter-in-law.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Lakhbir Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 07th of January, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
