The petitioner is a lady, who being related to deceased Sophia as maternal aunt, has been involved in the case which was registered at the instance of Satinder Pal Singh. As per the story of prosecution, during the course of investigation, it was found that the deceased and the petitioner had a minor dispute, on account of her relationship with Aditya Kumar, as a result of which hot words were exchanged and during the course of grappling, the deceased accidentally fell down from the stairs and hit her head on the ladder resulting in her death. Thereafter, her dead body was thrown in the canal.

There were three material witnesses of extra-judicial confession, last seen and motive in the shape of statements of Pargat Singh, Sardool Singh and Aditya Kumar, respectively.

Counsel for the petitioner has made available the statements of all the witnesses recorded during trial. They have turned hostile and not supported the case of prosecution. The petitioner has been in

custody with effect from 31.01.2016. In view of the above said circumstances, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
