By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.70 dated 01.07.2015, registered under Sections 295-A, 120-B IPC and Section 67-A of Information & Technology Act, at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran.

On 07.04.2016, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Petitioner allegedly sent obscene messages to Nishan Singh complainant who is a religious man.

Notice to the Advocate General, Punjab, for 8.7.2016.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioner will join investigation on or before 16.4.2016. In case of petitioner doing so, he shall be released on interim

bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 07.04.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 07.04.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
