Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 CrPC is for issuance of direction to respondents no.1 to 4 to fairly investigate the complaint, as lodged by the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of ASI Rajwant Singh, Incharge, Police Post Sunder Nagar, P.S. Dresi Ludhiana, respondent no.4, which is taken on record.

Reply on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3 is already on record.

As per the reply filed on behalf of respondent no.4, the petitioner had moved an application dated 18.6.2016 before the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, respondent no.2, on which, an enquiry was conducted by the SHO and the allegations levelled by the petitioner against respondents no.5 and 6, who are son and daughter-in-law of the

petitioner, were found false. Reply further suggests that proceedings under Sections 107/151 CrPC have been initiated against respondents no.5 and 6.

In view the categorical stand taken on behalf of respondent no.4, wherein it has been stated that though the allegations made by the petitioner in his complaint dated 18.6.2016 have been found to be false, however, on the recommendation of the SHO, proceedings under Section 107/151 CrPC have already been initiated against respondents no.5 and 6, no further order is called for in the present petition.
