1. Whether reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment ?

Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.4 as they entered into matrimony against his wishes.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 08.04.2016, petitioner No.1-Ajay Kumar has deposited an amount of ₹ 50,000/- in the shape of FDR in the name of petitioner No.2-Anu Shukla. He has produced photocopy of the FDR. The same is taken on record.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners are living happily.

Learned State counsel on instructions from S.I. Madan Lal states that the petitioners as well as respondent No.4 have made a statement to the effect that they do not apprehend threat/danger to their life and liberty.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.
