Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect
the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents
No.4 to 8.

This Court vide order dated 7.4.2016 had granted
interim protection to the petitioners on the undertaking of
petitioner no.2 that he is ready to deposit a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- in
favour of petitioner no.1-girl , by way of an FDR for three years,

in order to create a sense of security in her mind and also to prove his *bona fide* as regards his commitment to the relationship. On last date of hearing i.e. 29.4.2016, an adjournment was sought on behalf of the petitioner to comply with the order dated 7.4.2016.

However, today, learned counsel for the petitioner pleads no instructions in the matter.

Since the petitioner no.2 has failed to comply with the order dated 7.4.2016, this petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
