The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 82 dated 28.10.2014 registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station Women Cell, District Jalandhar.

Notice of motion was issued in the case on 8.4.2015 and thereafter the case has been adjourned on various dates.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State on instructions from ASI Hardev Singh submits that the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender and this fact was also brought to the notice of this Court on the last date of hearing i.e. 4.12.2015.

Since the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender, no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to him.
