Petitioner has been in custody with effect from 23.09.2015 for having been found in possession of 80 kg of poppy husk. The quantity recovered is commercial and a period of about one year has elapsed in custody.

The quantity recovered being marginally higher than the commercial prescribed, striking a balance between the right of liberty of the petitioner and the claim of the prosecution agency, simultaneously considering the stringent provision of Section 37 of the NDPS Act, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition at this stage with a direction that the trial Court shall make an earnest endeavour to record the entire evidence of the prosecution by giving short dates of hearing. In case all of the prosecution witnesses are not examined within a period of five months, after the next date of hearing, petitioner will be

released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
