The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.153 dated 28.10.2015 under sections 61/1/14 of Excise Act and sections 420, 467, 468, 471 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Division No.2, District Ludhiana.

Counsel having argued the matter at some length, prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Counsel submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to surrender and prays that, if, thereafter an application for bail is filed, directions be issued for deciding such bail application forthwith.

As per submission made by counsel the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, observed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the Investigating Agency/Illaq Magistrate concerned, within a period of one week from today and thereafter moves an application seeking bail, the same would be considered strictly on merits and an endeavor would be made to expedite disposal of the same.
