Three petitioners, namely, Parkash Singh, Raj Bashambar Singh and Kuldeep Kaur are seeking anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. on having been summoned as additional accused to face trial on an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.231 dated 02.12.2008, under Sections 452, 380, 323, 34, 506, IPC (Annexure P-2), registered with Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar.

It is contended that the summoning orders were never properly served upon the petitioners/accused due to incorrect addresses. Thus, it is submitted that the order dated 02.12.2015 declaring them as proclaimed offenders is liable to be quashed.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the directions passed by this Court vide order dated 11.04.2016, petitioner has surrendered himself before the trial Court and has been granted bail vide order dated 18.04.2016.

Learned State Counsel assisted by HC Ramesh Kumar is unable to refute the aforesaid submissions made on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the above, interim bail granted by the trial Court vide order dated 18.04.2016 pursuant to the directions passed by this Court vide order dated 11th of April, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
