Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.17 dated 21.2.2016, under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 IPC and Section 12 of the Passport Act, 1967, registered at Police Station Dina Nagar, District Gurdaspur.

This Court vide order dated 11.4.2016, while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to his joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid

down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 11.4.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Surjit Singh, has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 11.4.2016 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
