This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.82 dated 21.3.2015 under sections 420, 406 I.P.C registered at Police Station, Sushant Lok, District Gurgaon.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

F.I.R came to be registered on the complaint of one Vikas son of Mahender Singh. Allegations relate back to the year 2012 and complainant has asserted that he had come in touch with the present petitioner, who claimed himself to be the Director of Full Light Films based in Mumbai. Allegations are that a sum of Rs.13,50,000/- has been taken from the complainant on the pretext of teaching him acting/providing him a career in the films and such money has been misappropriated. It is also the assertion of the complainant that even an agreement to such effect had been entered into and part of the amount was transferred in the account of the accused/present petitioner through R.T.G.S mode.

Petitioner was arrested on 20.2.2016.

Apparently, the present petitioner has even issued cheques for a total amount of Rs.8 lacs and which on presentation have been dishonored.

The dispute between the parties stems from an agreement having been entered into. This is the version of the complainant himself. Dispute, as such, is essentially civil in nature.

Petitioner has faced incarceration since 20.2.2016.

State counsel would submit that investigation in the case has already been completed and even the challan has been prepared and finalized on 18.4.2016.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Gurgaon.

Petition disposed of.
