The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 89 dated 10.05.2014 registered at Police Station Fazilka, District Fazilka under Sections 363/366(A), 376(D) IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act(added later on).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 10.05.2014 and the prosecutrix was more than 18 years of age and the FIR had been lodged with the delay of 4 days.

Learned State counsel submits that the trial is at the fag end and only one witness remains to be examined and the case is fixed today before the trial Court.

The prosecution is only to examine its last witness. The prosecutrix has made a statement against the petitioner. Two of the accused could not be arrested and are proclaimed offenders.

No case for bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
