This is second petition filed by the petitioner seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 122 dated 11.08.2015 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur under Sections 341/354/354-A/354-B/354-D/295-A/506/379/323/34 IPC alongwith Section 7/8 of Prevention of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Sections 376/328/120-B IPC added later on.

The first bail application seeking anticipatory bail was dismissed on merits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the Superintendent of Police has now conducted an enquiry and found the statement of the complainant to be doubtful and, therefore, they have again filed petition for anticipatory bail.

The matter was argued at length. The petition was dismissed on merits . The allegation against the accused are of raping the girl stated to be in the age group of 16-16 ½ years. It had also been stated there that the petitioner side were pressuring them for compromise.

The petition is dismissed as it is not maintainable.
