Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Ramesh and Sandeep in case FIR No.353 dated 17.12.2015 for offence punishable under Section 380 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Nangal Chaudhary, District Mahendergarh.

Complainant Raj Bala is wife of Krishan Kumar who is real brother of petitioner no.1-Ramesh and *Chacha* of petitioner no.2-Sandeep.

As per allegations petitioners-accused have stolen household articles from a house allegedly jointly owned in their ancestral village.

It is contended that said Krishan Kumar and his complainant

wife were residing in a separate village since last more than 25 years having been separated from the family after getting their share. However, now a false case has been foisted upon them with a view to gain a portion of the ancestral house. It is submitted that on inquiry by DSP, petitioners were found innocent.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submit that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Dharamvir Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 14th of January, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
