RITU BAHRI, J.

The petitioners are seeking direction to the respondents to prepare a proper and logical duty roster for the lady constables working as E.T.P. Operators.

This petition was admitted on 09.02.1998. Thereafter, vide order dated 06.11.2001, a miscellaneous application i.e. CM No.30533 of 2001, whereby the applicant-petitioners had sought direction to the respondents not to depute the lady constables on night duty, was dismissed. While dismissing the said application, reference was made to a letter dated 25.10.2001 issued by the Director General of Police, Haryana to the Inspector General of Police, Telecommunication, Haryana, whereby he had communicated a decision to continue with the present duty roster system, vide which lady constables were performing their duties during day and availing one day weekly rest.

After issuance of the said letter dated 25.10.2001, this case has come up for final disposal today and more than 15 years have gone by since

then.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to challenge any duty roster, vide which, night duty is sought to be taken from the lady constables in future.
