The petitioner is alleged to have duped the complainant of a sum of Rs. 1 lac with a promise that he would get sale deed executed in favour of the complainant from the original owner.

State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined investigation.

There does not appear to be any document available on the record till date as per the police file indicating that money had been handed over. Petitioner is stated to be involved in another case of cheating registered at the instance of Jagroop Singh.

Taking into consideration the nature of the material gathered by the investigating agency till date and the petitioner having already joined investigation, he can be granted the concession of pre-arrest bail.

The petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, he shall be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the condition that he would join investigation as and when required and will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner.

Nothing said in this order will prejudice the right of the complainant to recover the amount by adopting alternative remedies, if any, available to him under any law.
