This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.78 dated 18.06.2013, under Sections 326/325/323/324/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar.

On 14.01.2016, while issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.78, dated 18.06.2013, under Sections 326/325/323/324/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar.

Counsel would inter alia contend that the injury attributed to the present petitioner is a datar blow and to a non-vital part of the body. It is submitted that the petitioner is otherwise ready and willing to join investigation.

Notice of motion, returnable on 08.03.2016.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/ Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Balraj Singh would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 14.01.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute.
