The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.244 dated 19.12.2015, registered under Sections 353, 332, 186, 224, 225, 506 and 294 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Division No.7, Ludhiana City.

Heard.

On 11.04.2016, the following order was passed:-

“Counsel would place reliance upon an order dated 06.04.2016 passed by this Court in CRM No.M-9857 of 2016 whereby co-accused Gurpreet Kaur and Surjit Singh have been granted ad interim protection as regards arrest.

Notice of motion, returnable for 20.07.2016.

To be listed along with CRM No.M-9857 of 2016.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer and to join investigation.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and they shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 11.04.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
